

CHESIL MODEL FLYING CLUB (CMFC)

Covid 19 --- Additional measures, guidance & rules for CMFC member activity at the “Pymore” flying site.

1. ***If you or any of your household have tested positive within the last 14 days &/or are displaying (Covid-19) symptoms, stay away from the field and follow the current isolation advice.***
2. ***Act in accordance with your own level of risk and vulnerability and consider that of others.***
3. ***Not used***
4. ***Maintain a minimum of 2 metres ‘social distance’ from other people (unless from the same household) at all times.***
5. ***Maintain good hygiene practice – washing hands regularly or using hand sanitizer or suitable gloves when opening & closing gates/shed or using maintenance equipment.***
6. ***Keep hand sanitizer in your flight box/car (and use it!) – Additional PPE may be appropriate if used correctly. The toilet will be open with hand soap provided.***
7. ***Do not share flying equipment.***

9. ***Access to the “bus”: It is currently recommended that not more than 2 members are in the bus at any one time & that it is advised to wash hands before and after entering and using any equipment in the bus.***

15. ***Do not enter the farm yard and stay away from the farm buildings and equipment.***
16. ***Keep your distance from the land owners and the farm workers.***
17. ***The landowners are aware of the above rules and will be ensuring that they are being adhered to.***

These rules have been developed from the Government Guidance and BMFA advice relating to the current Covid -19 situation. These rules have also been agreed with the land owner, and many of them are a prerequisite to allow the site to open & stay open, so please abide by them.
